

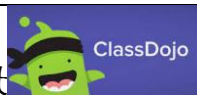

<p>Dojo Post </p>	<p>Post prior to the day and also pictures of some of the artwork that the children produce.</p>
<p>Art work</p>	<p>Each class needs to create a piece of artwork based on MLK's speech. I've pasted some examples of what we want them to look like below. Discuss what the 'I Have a Dream' speech is about and explain to the children that they are going to write a few phrases of what they dream about e.g. everyone to be treated fairly, end of racism, all people to work together harmoniously etc. Each phrase should begin 'I have a dream...'</p> <p>You'll need to take pictures of the kids (e.g. thinking, shouting, pointing upwards etc) and then stick it onto the background. I have attached the links to the background that each year group needs to use below. The children need to write the phrases on white strips of paper.</p> <p>. EYFS you can just do one phrase for your class. If it is proving to be too difficult, then they can do something else.</p>
