
1. The collation
 When a man feels God is calling him to be a priest he will have to be seen accepted by the bishop and will have to both to be a priest. After he will have to make a promise of celibacy and obedience to the bishop.



2. Holy orders
 At the end of training he still wants to be a priest he will be ordained - that is the sacrament of ordination. This is celebrated in mass and it is the bishop who presides the sacrament.



3. Gospel and Introit
 After this the pope and normally the ordinand is called returned from the parish family to parish.



4. The laying on of hands
 The bishop lays his hands on the head of the ordinand and prays for consecration and he will receive his stole and chalice.



5. Anointing and blessing
 The Bishop anoints the priest's hands with the oil of Chrism and then he is anointed and blessed. Now he is a priest and he will be blessed by the bishop's.





The Annunciation





In this picture, Elizabeth felt her baby move at the moment's news. Mary told her. Mary and Elizabeth look very excited about news.


The Annulus prayer

God.





- The ceremony of lighting the Paschal candle is one of the most solemn moments of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.
- On the same ^{day} special and sacred fire is lit that represents the rise of Christ whose light dispelled in the darkness.
- The Paschal candle is the first one to be lit. It is the one from which all other lights are taken.
- In most cases today the candle the Greek letters: alpha and omega (kinda like A and Z) which mean "Christ is at the beginning and the end of all things."
- There will also be a cross which represents Jesus and his eternal life.

Grains of incense: They represent the 5 wounds of Christ. Here it reminds us of God's presence here and now.

I think the Paschal candle helps to represent Easter.

Represents the light of Jesus that he gave to us.
