



The Advent Wreath

As Christians we believe that Advent means coming. But what do the candles mean? Well on the Advent Wreath there are four candles with different meanings. The first candle is Hope. Hope is a purple candle that is lit on the first Sunday of Advent. The second candle is the candle of preparation. This candle is also purple and is lit on the second Sunday of Advent. The third, forth and fifth candle is: Joy, Love and the Christ candle. Joy is pink, Love is purple and the Christ candle is white.

The Advent Wreath has a very special meaning. A clearer bit (the wreath itself) represents Jesus. He is everlasting and God. The light on Advent candle means Jesus is the light of the world. Holly leaf means the crown of thorns because of how spiny holly leaves are.

Isaiah's reading teaches us the preparation of our after life. In his reading he mentions that God will swallow up death and that he will destroy the shroud that enfolds all people. At the end of Isaiah verse "up" he says 'we trusted in and he saved us' means that we believed in him and answered us.

What do Christians do during Lent and why do they do this?

Lent is important because during Lent, Christians are waiting and preparing for Jesus to die for us on Good Friday but hopefully ~~resurrect~~ rise again on Easter Sunday. During Lent, Christians fast, pray and they do almsgiving. In school, we have been bringing in £1 to support a charity called CAFOD. When Christians fast, they would usually eat 1 whole meal and 2 half meals. On Ash Wednesday, ~~they~~ go to church to get ashes on ~~their~~ foreheads. They do this because in the Bible, it says that Jesus didn't eat anything ^{in the desert} for 40 days and He was tempted by the Devil.

During Lent, Christians fast, pray and do almsgiving. Fasting is when you ~~are~~ give up something for a time. Praying is when you pray to God to get strength when you are in a difficult time and almsgiving is when you give something to the less fortunate. But they also have Palm Sunday, and on that day, every Christian has to go to church. The priest would give everybody a cross made out of palms.

Jesus prepared for his death ^{by} ~~by~~ the Last Supper with his disciples. At the Last Supper, Jesus washed all the disciples feet. He did this so that his disciples could also understand that you can serve others, no matter who you are. Jesus said, "Do this in remembrance of me." When He was in the garden of Gethsemane, He was praying to God that He is really


scared to die. After a few minutes, his betrayer, Jude came and Jesus said "My betrayer is at hand". Judas came with soldiers to crucify Jesus.

Christians believe that Pontius Pilot was a good man and he was. When Judas wanted to crucify Jesus Pontius Pilot didn't have any good reason to do that he asked the people "Should I let Jesus free?" but they said "no!". So during Lent, Christians pray for Jesus. That's why purple represents royalty.

So during this time, we pray for each other and we try to remember and thank Jesus that He sacrificed His life for our sins. We remember Jesus as being very humble man.


Ch1 - Explaining the symbols of pentecost

What do Christians do during Lent
and why do they do this?

Lent is about some of Jesus' events in his life and it is also about preparing and waiting for Jesus' resurrection. Lent is important to Christians because we see how Jesus sacrifices his life for us. During Lent we pray, fast and give. This links to when Jesus was tested in the wilderness in Luke 4:1-12.

As a Christian we believe that burnt palm leaves come from when Jesus was riding to Jerusalem on a donkey while everyone was waving palm leaves. The Palm leaves are burnt and are turned into ashes. On Palm Sunday, we go church and the priest gives us a cross made out of palm leaves.

After Jesus had his last supper with his disciples, he went in the garden of Gethsemane. He prayed to God asking for protection and guidance ~~and protection~~ because he was really scared that he called God Abba which means daddy. Jesus was so worried because he didn't want to die and he was lying down on the floor. He was about to be betrayed and arrested on the same day. The person who betrayed and got Jesus arrested was... Judas, one of Jesus' disciples and he did it for money and he was jealous.

The person who sentenced Jesus to death was Pontius Pilate. Pontius Pilate was a good man because when he ask Jesus what happened he realised he couldn't see what was wrong. He wanted to set Jesus free but one of the soldiers reminded him that Jesus did not ~~die~~ die. Then he will not be the friend of the emperor. Pontius Pilate did want that to happen so he made Jesus die.

During this time we thank Jesus for saving us and sacrificing his life for us because it is not everyday someone dies for you or your sins. We remember how Jesus was here for us and loved us all equally. We also remember Jesus was scared to die but he still died for which shows his love.
